

Following the latest Government guidance we have adopted measures to keep our staff safe, while doing our utmost to maintain our usual standard of work and consistency in meeting the expectations of our customers, and ensuring that deliveries are processed and shipped in a timely manner.

Currently only one member of staff is in the office at any one time, to handle deliveries/shipments. The rest of us are working from home where we are able to log-in to our central server securely and remotely. Please forgive us if the telephone is not answered in our usual timely fashion.

Staff manning the office are taking preventative measures by following enhanced hygiene procedures, such as hand washing, sanitising and observing the 2m distance rule with any delivery drivers. Of course we have cancelled any business travel or visits to customers, and are replacing face to face meetings with phone and video calls.

Our shipments from our German principals and to our domestic customers are handled by TNT, who are following their own rigid company guidelines on contact with goods in/goods out personnel.

Currently our principals are continuing to manufacture and have adopted their own procedures regarding home working and maintaining distance between factory workers. To date we have not experienced any significant delays in the supply chain however working restrictions and enhanced health checking at border crossings inevitably will add to lead times to varying degrees.

We will keep updating our situation through this medium at regular intervals as the situation unfolds.
